We gratefully appreciate all contributions which help us to continue with Haywood Village Church. We require ongoing funds to pay for hall hire crafts and refreshments on an ongoing basis. If you feel you are able to give regularly by standing order to support the work of the Church please complete this form. Alternatively there are donations baskets at Church events.

What happens to the money I give to support Haywood Village Church?

The donation will be made via our parent church Locking Castle Church which is a registered charity in England number 1170425 and the gifts will be restricted for use at Haywood Village Church and related activities and will help cover costs such as hall hire, refreshments and crafts.

How can I give?

We operate several schemes to help you plan your giving effectively, depending on whether or not you pay tax and how often you wish to make regular payments. The only people who will know how much you give are the Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer and the Gift Aid secretary and it is completely confidential.

1) Standing Order:

You can simply instruct your bank to set up a regular payment to the following account: Sort code: **60-23-06** (NatWest) Account No: **57525358** - *Locking Castle Christian Partnership*. If you would like us to arrange this for you please complete the Bankers Order part of this leaflet and deliver it for the attention of the Treasurer at the Church office at Locking Castle Church, Jasmine Way, Locking Castle, Weston-Super-Mare. BS24 7JW or place in the donations basket at one of our events in a sealed envelope.

Please mark it clearly reference Haywood Village Church to ensure that it is allocated to the right place.

If you are a taxpayer, please complete the Gift Aid form as we can then reclaim tax back from HMRC to boost your donation.

2) Donations at events

You can donate in the donation baskets at Church events by cash or cheque.

3) **Cash or Cheque.**

You can also give cash or cheques regularly and/or one off gifts of any amount. If you are a tax payer, and have completed a Gift Aid form, please write on the back of the cheque 'Gift Aid' or if giving cash, please put in an envelope and write your name and 'Gift Aid' on it.

What is tithing?

Tithing is a biblical principle meaning giving away a tenth of what we have. Tithing income was a requirement of the Old Testament law, but Jesus just encouraged his followers to give generously, but not out of any legalistic feeling of duty. You shouldn't give, for example, if you are facing mounting debts or are in financial jeopardy. However the Apostle Paul adds:

'See to it that you excel in this grace of giving.' 2 Cor 8v7

'Whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Everyone should give what they have decided in their hearts to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.' 2 Corinthians 9v7
